## Junior

(Ages 9-10) (P4-P5) (WWJ) | Theme: Narrative & Diaries – Man & Nature

From towering mountains to enchanted forests, this course explores the deep connection between man and nature through both storytelling and analytical reading. Students will develop their skills in descriptive and expository writing, learning to craft vivid fables and compelling narratives while also structuring informative texts.



### Language Skills

- Students will learn to identify, analyse, and apply key literary and writing techniques, including theme, morals, imagery, and point of view (P.O.V.).



### Assessments

- Unit 1: Written test + Narrative writing task (Story with a moral)
- Unit 2: Written test + Expository writing task

## Intermediate

(Ages 11-12) (P6-S1) (WWI) | Theme: Narrative & Persuasive – Myths Beneath the Wavesture

Exploring the vastness of the ocean and the mysteries beneath the waves, students will dive into classical creation myths and craft their own imaginative fables. Through both narrative and persuasive writing, they will learn to structure compelling stories and develop arguments, refining their ability to analyse and create impactful texts.



### Language Skills

- Students will enhance their writing through the implementation of personification, foreshadowing, symbolism, perspective, and tone.



### Assessments

- Unit 1: Written test + Narrative writing task (Original fable)
- Unit 2: Written test + Persuasive writing task (Newspaper article based on a fable—either one they wrote or one studied in class)
